

## CONTRACTED SERVICES

The Area Agency on Aging works in partnership with local agencies to provide services in the community and in the home to older adults, 60+ years of age and to caregivers of older adults

### Services in the Community

- **Meals:** Enjoy hot, freshly prepared meals in a friendly social setting. Cost to seniors 60+ years of age is on a suggested donation basis. See below to call for reservations:

- **Legal Assistance:** Legal services provided at no cost to low-income seniors. Services include guardianships, probate, Medicaid eligibility and Social Security benefits. Contact:

### Home Supports

Requests for supports in the home for the following services must be approved by an Area Agency on Aging case manager.

- **Home Delivered Meals:** For homebound seniors, 60+ years of age, who are unable to leave home without assistance and have difficulty preparing meals, may have meals delivered to the home. Meals may be hot and/or frozen. Cost to the senior: suggested donation.
- **Homemaker Services:** For seniors, 60+ years of age, this service provides light housekeeping to help keep individuals safe in their homes. Standby assistance with bathing is also available. Cost to the senior: sliding fee scale.
- **Respite:** Provides a short “break” for a family caregiver doing 24/7 care of a loved one, 60+ years of age. Volunteer seniors will sit with the loved one for a few hours each week. This service is provided at no cost.
- **Family Caregiver Respite:** Respite is provided at no cost by skilled caregivers in the home, at adult day centers and skilled nursing facilities.
