

Case Management

Case Management is a consumer-driven service intended to empower and assist individuals, caregivers and families in making choices concerning in-home, community-based or long-term care services. This service is provided by licensed social workers who as case manager coach clients and caregivers in developing systems utilizing the family, friends and neighbors to support the needs of the individual.

The case manager links clients and their families with available services including free, cost sharing, and fee for service options which facilitate life adjustments and bolster informal supports.

Some areas addressed could be self-care, financial and legal resources, basic supplemental services like meal preparation or home delivered meals, light housekeeping, stand by bath assistance that are designed to compliment services that family, friends or neighbors are able physically or financially to provide.

Our goal is to support the efforts of the family, friends or neighbors not to replace them. Case managers provide an accurate assessment of functional abilities and formulate a plan of care around the goal of the individual. Transitions in care are explored so individuals know how to utilize temporary care like rehabilitation or supplemental services in order to return to functional levels and remain in or return to home.
