

The **Kootenai County Elder/Vulnerable Adult Multi-Disciplinary Team**'s mission is the prevention of abuse through agency collaboration, consultation and education. Formation of the team reflects a growing consensus that no single agency or discipline has all the resources or expertise needed to effectively resolve all forms of abuse and neglect. The use of multidisciplinary teams is becoming a hallmark of elder abuse prevention programs. Under the leadership of the local Adult Protection Program, a team of individuals from Kootenai County has formed the area's first elder/vulnerable adult abuse multidisciplinary team.
