Area Agency on Aging Establishes Endowment

The demand for services to keep seniors safe at home far exceeds available resources. In answer to this need the Area Agency on Aging has partnered with Inland Northwest Community Foundation (INWCF) to establish the *Aging Services for North Idaho Endowment*.

What is an Endowment?

An endowment represents the establishment of an income generating fund (principal) which generates investment income (interest) to ensure the future funding of critically needed services. The principal is never spent, but the interest income generated is utilized by the organization to meet the established goals and purpose of the endowment.

How will this endowment be used?

The Area Agency on Aging provides, coordinates, and funds numerous community and in-home services for aging adults including: Homemaker services, Family caregiver respite, Information and referral, Home delivered meals, Senior center meals, Long-term care facility advocates, Adult protective services, Friendship Corps, Retired and senior volunteers, social worker home visit.
